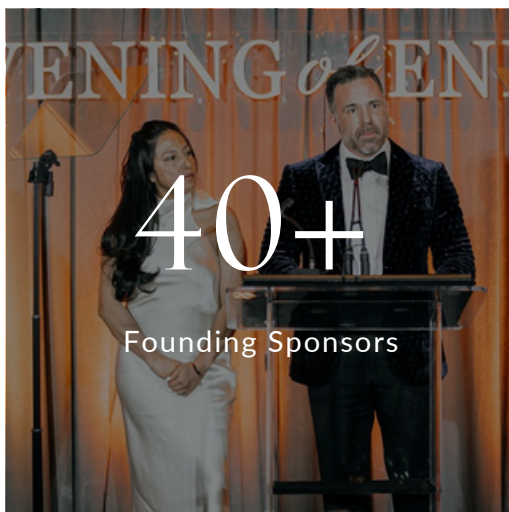
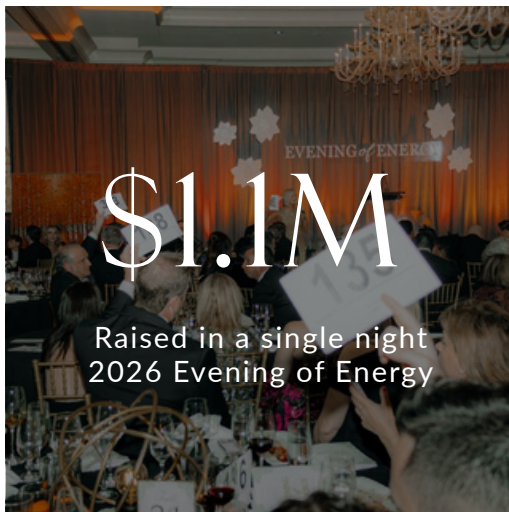

More than a gala

Countdown is not just a gala. It is a growing initiative building the first coordinated ecosystem dedicated to advancing mitochondrial science and a new era of human health. Through strategic partnerships, a flagship fundraising event, and growing momentum across science, medicine, and consumer health, Countdown is bringing cellular energy — and mitochondrial science — into mainstream conversations around health, aging, performance, and disease.

But building a future where mitochondrial health is central to how we understand, prevent, and treat disease will require greater investment and awareness. Despite mitochondria's role across nearly every aspect of human health, **mitochondrial science has historically received less than 1% of philanthropic funding**. Together, we have an opportunity to change that.



Our challenge

A hidden Crisis

Mitochondrial dysfunction sits at the center of a wide range of diseases, including Alzheimer's, Parkinson's, ALS, cancer, and more. It touches every family, yet remains one of the most overlooked and underfunded areas of medicine.

The body isn't a silo

For decades, medicine has advanced organ by organ, disease by disease, yet beneath and upstream from every system is what powers it all: cellular energy, driven by the trillions of mitochondria within our cells.

The funding gap

Nonprofit foundations contribute billions to U.S. medical research each year, yet mitochondrial and cellular energy science has historically received less than 1% of that funding.

Our opportunity

A new era of health

Consumer behavior is shifting toward longevity, prevention, and science-backed health solutions, and Countdown — the only organization dedicated to accelerating mitochondrial science and medicine across the full spectrum of human health — is leading a new era of health.

We believe this new era is proactive, personalized, and energy-driven, addressing dysfunction at the cellular level before it appears in labs, scans, and symptoms. As technology, AI, diagnostics, and funding accelerate discovery, mitochondrial science is rapidly moving from the margins to the center of modern medicine.

By connecting researchers, clinicians, institutions, philanthropy, brands, and the public, Countdown is transforming fragmented science into real-world impact and accelerating actionable outcomes now, not decades from now.

OUR APPROACH

From siloed to connected

When mitochondrial function declines, the effects can ripple across multiple systems, contributing to fatigue, brain fog, inflammation, accelerated aging, and many of the most pressing diseases of our time.

Because this dysfunction begins at the level of cellular energy — upstream from where symptoms appear — it often goes undetected by standard medical testing, which currently lacks the ability to measure mitochondrial health. By accelerating mitochondrial research, we have the opportunity to transform medicine itself, shifting from reacting to disease after it appears to detecting, preventing, and treating dysfunction at its source.
